

Re survey of East Bdy of T 27 N, R 35 E.
(Humboldt River Guide Meridian)

chains

sec., 6 ft. dist; and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Note. This cor. is 4 miles north of cor. to Tps 26 and 27 N, Rs 35 and 36 E, and on a right line between the two Twp cor. of the east Bdy.

Land, level.

Soil, sand and alkali.

No vegetation.

North Boundary of T 27 N, R 35 E.

May-21-1913. At 8 a.m., l.m.t., I set off $40^{\circ} 15'$ on the lat. arc; and $20^{\circ} 10' N$, on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar, at the cor. of Tps. 27 and 28 N, Rs. 35 and 36 E., which is an iron post, heretofore described.

Thence I run

West, bet. secs. 1 and 36 on a true line. Over level ground; through lake bed.
