dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., E. and W. of post, 3 ft. dist; and raise a mound of earth, 3½ ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor. Thence run N89°47'E, from ¼ sec. cor.

40.02 Destroy all traces of old cor. and at same point, set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam; 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, with brass cap, marked,

40.05 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam, 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Tps. 28 and 29N, Rs. 35 and 36 E. with a brass cap, marked
