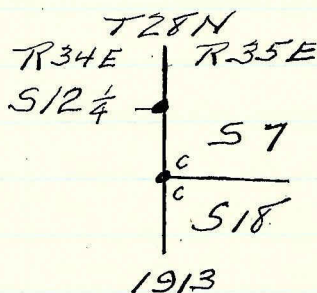
48.00 Ridge bears S.E. and N.W.; descend.

57.50 Gulch, 20 lbs. wide, bears N and S; ascend steep slope. Amineus powder house, cabin and mine bears N. about 10, 15 and 20 chs. dist.

69.00 Ridge bears, 525° E, and N 25° W, thence over ridge.

72.97 Intersect the W. bdy of Tp. 324 chs. $50^{\circ}09'14''$ W, from $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 12, which is a rock heretofore described.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of sec 7 and 18, with brass cap, marked,



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of cor.
