

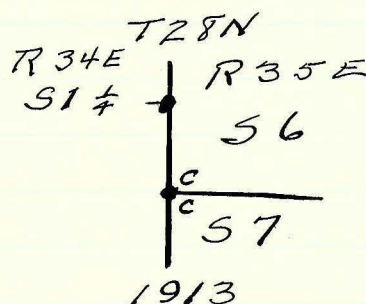
Subdivision of T28N, R35E

chains West, on a true line bet.
secs. 6 and 7.
Over mountainous land;
ascend.
10.00 Top of spur, bears $N65^{\circ}E$, and $S65^{\circ}W$;
descend.
40.00 Set iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in.
in diam., 24 ins. in the
ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with
brass cap marked.

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and raise a mound of stone,
2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N of cor.
42.60 Enter wash, 30 lbs. wide, 2 ft.
deep, course $N20^{\circ}E$.
45.60 Enter wash, 35 lbs. wide, 3 ft.
deep, course $N80^{\circ}E$, ascend.
72.90 Intersect the W. bdy. of Tp. 249
chr. $50^{\circ}09'W$. of $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec 1,
which is a rock, never before de-
scribed.
