

Resurvey of the S. bdy. of fracl. T. 39 N., R. 36 E.

Chains

November 14, 1913. *Surveyed by Thos A Haigh.*

Beginning at the cor. of Tps. 38 and 39 N., Rs. 36 and 37 E., at 9 h., a. m., l. m. t., I set off $18^{\circ}10'$ S. on the decl. arc, and $41^{\circ}11'$ N. on the lat. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar;

Thence I retrace

West on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 36.

49.12 Intersect a point 16 lks. N. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a pine stake, 3 X 3 ins., 14 ins. above ground, marked as described by the surveyor general, and set in a trace of an earth mound.

Course of this half mile is S. $89^{\circ}49'$ W.

I continue same line west and at

90.33 Intersect a point 17 lks. S. of the old cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, which is pine stake 3 X 3 ins, 12 ins. above ground, set in SW. pit, marks obliterated, mound and pits plainly in evidence.

Course of last half mile is N. $89^{\circ}32'$ W.

Beginning at the old cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36,

Thence I run

West on a random line bet. secs. 2 and 35.

40.73 Intersect a point 11 lks. S. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a pine post, 3 X 3 ins, 16 ins. above ground, and marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.

Course of this half mile is N. $89^{\circ}51'$ W.

I continue same line west, and at

81.16 Intersect a point 28 lks. S. of the old cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, which is a well defined trace of mound and pits, no marked stake or stone found.

Course of last half mile is N. $89^{\circ}46'$ W.

I return to the cor. of Tps. 38 and 39 N., Rs. 36 and 37 E. and at 11h. 50m., a. m., l. m. t., set off $18^{\circ}13'$ S. on the decl. arc, and at noon observe the sun on the meridian for latitude and find the reading on
