- Chains Nov. 17, 1913. *Surveyed by Alex. J. Harris*
- Beginning at the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the township, at 9 h., a. m., l. m. t., I set off  $18^{\circ} 55\frac{1}{2}'$  S. on the decl. arc, and  $41^{\circ} 11'$  N. on the lat. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar;
- Thence I run
- North  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. bet. secs. 35 and 36, on a sectional guide meridian.
