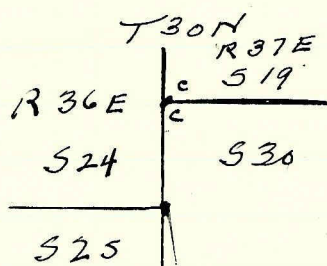


Subdivision of T30N, R37E.

Chains

- raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.
- 42.00 Top of spur, bears, N.W. and S.E.; descend.
- 60.00 Leave hills descend over rolling ground, bears, N.W. and S.E.
- 83.85 Intersect the W. bdy. of Twp. 7.48 chs. $70^{\circ}05'$ W. of cor. of secs. 24 and 25, which is an iron post heretofore described. Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30, with a brass cap, marked.

raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of cor.

Land hilly, and rolling. Soil, sandy loam, shallow, light and dry, subsoil gravelly to stony, vegetation sage brush, No timber, Drains N.W.

July-17-1913

- From the cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19, and 20. I run West, on a true line bet. secs 18 and 19. Descend over rolling ground.
- 10.00 Enter wash, 30 chs. wide, course $58^{\circ}00'$ W.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam.; 24 ins in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec cor., with a
