Surveyed by Alex. J. Harris
 June 26, 1913: at 10^h a.m. l.m.t. I set
 off 40°35' on the lat. arc, 23°23' N.
 on the decl. arc; and determine a
 meridian with the solar, at the
 cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N, R. 36 E.,
 Thence I retrace

South, bet. secs. 1 and 6, at 40.98
 chs. fall 3 lks. W. of old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec cor.
 which is a small juniper stake
 almost decayed, with loose mound
 of stone to W. the line
 bears, 50°02'E, and at 38.84 chs. south
 from $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. fall 47 lks. E. of cor. of secs. 1, 6,
 7 and 12, which is a juniper stake
 with markings nearly obliter-
 ated, this line bears, 50°42'W.

June-28-1913, at 9^h0^m a.m. l.m.t. I set
 off 40°34' on the lat. arc, 23°19' N, on
 the decl. arc; and determine a
 meridian with the solar at
 old cor. of secs 1, 6, 7, and 12,
 Thence I retrace
 South, bet. secs. 7 and 12, at
 40.00 chs. find no trace of
 $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., build temp $\frac{1}{4}$ sec.
 cor., and continue on same line,
 at 80.68 chs. fall 39 lks. E of cor.
 of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, which is
 a juniper stake, 3x3x24 ins.
 above ground, marked and
 witnessed as described by the
 surveyor general. The line
 bears, 50°17'W.

June-30-1913: At 8^h0^m a.m. l.m.t. I
 set off 40°33' on the lat. arc, 23°13'
 N, on the decl. arc; and determine
 a meridian with the solar
 at cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13, and 18.
 Thence I retrace E. at 40.52 chs.
