

Resurvey of Subdivision of T31N, R37E.

Chains

22.00 Gulch, 10 lks. wide, course, N E.; ascend.

29.50 Spur, bears, E. and W.; descend.

31.53 The standard cov. of secs. 34 and 35. which is an iron post here to fore, described.

Land, hilly.

Soil, sandy loam, and stony, 3rd and 4th rate.

Under growth, sage brush and bunch grass.

No timber.

July-16-1913: at 8 am., 1 m. t.; I set off 40°35' on the lat. arc, 21°25' N., on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar. at cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on N. Bdy of T31N Tp.

Thence I run 50°01'E., on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 2. Over level ground.

1.10 Enter wash, 20 lks. wide, course N 70° E.

13.00 Enter wash, 20 lks. wide, course E.

40.00 Set iron post, 3 ft. long, in in draw, 24 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cov., with brass cap. marked,
