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Rais a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

66.50 Gully, 10 lks. wide, course SW., continue to desc.

71.33 Intersect west bdy. line of township 8.16 chs. N. $0^{\circ}19'$ E. of the cor. of Twps. 31 and 32 N., R. 36 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of Twps. 31 and 32 N., R. 37 E., with a brass cap, marked
