

Retracement and
Resurvey of Subdivision of T. 32 N., R. 37 E.

Chains North on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 2.

40.00 After diligent search fail to find any trace of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., I set temp. cor. and continue line.

78.28 Intersect the N. bdy. of the township, 7 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, thence I run S. $0^{\circ}03'$ E. on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 2.

Over level land covered with scattering sage-brush.

29.20 Dry wash, 30 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course E.

38.34 Proportionate distance, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for a new $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with a brass cap, marked

Dig pits, 18 X 18 X 12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

43.10 Dry wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course E.

62.10 Dry wash, 30 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course E.

72.80 Dry wash, 40 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course E.

78.28 Cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

Land level.

Soil sandy loam, 2nd. rate.

Undergrowth scattering sage-brush.

Drains E.

August 11, 1913.

Subdivision of T. 32 N., R. 37 E.

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 2 and 11, thence I run North on a true line bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Over gently rolling land, covered with scattering sage-brush.

0.15 Dry wash, 15 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course NE.

4.30 Dry wash, 15 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course N. 60° E.

4.40 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. for secs. 3 and 10, with a brass cap, marked
