

Subdivision of T. 32 N., R. 37 E.

Chains August 15, 1913.

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, at 8h, 30m. a. m., 1. m. t., I set off $14^{\circ} 08'$ N. on the decl. arc, and $40^{\circ} 40'$ N. on the lat. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar;

Thence I run

North bet. secs. 4 and 5.

Over rough mountainous land, through dense juniper.

0.50 Dry wash in cañon, 20 lks. wide, 7 ft. deep, course N. 80° E., asc. 400 ft.

11.00 Top of ridge, bears E. and W., desc.

15.00 Canon and wash in bottom, 30 lks. wide, course E. Asc. 350 ft.

24.00 Top of ridge, bears E. and W., desc. 300 ft.

29.50 Cañon, 40 lks. wide, 6 ft. deep, course E., asc. 200 ft.

39.00 Top of ridge, bears E. and W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with a brass cap, marked

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

54.75 Cañon, 60 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, course N. 60° E. Asc. 200 ft.

58.00 Top of ridge, bears E. and W., desc. 150 ft.

64.00 Cañon, 40 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, course E., asc. 200 ft.

68.00 Wire pasture fence, bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.

69.50 Top of ridge, bears N. 70° E., and S. 70° W., desc. 150 ft.

71.50 Dry wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course E., asc.

75.85 Intersect N. bdy. of township 4.51 chs. S. $89^{\circ} 55'$ W. of the cor. of secs. 32 and 33.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, with a brass cap, marked
