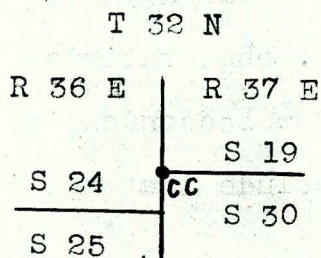


## Subdivision of T. 32 N., R. 37 E.

Chains  
 42.00 Top of spur, bears N. 20° W., desc.  
 43.00 Enter Rock Hill Canon, bears N. 20° W.  
 43.50 Creek in bottom of cañon, 20 lks. wide, <sup>2 ins. deep</sup> course N. 20° W.  
 44.50 Leave cañon, asc.  
 54.00 Point of spur, bears NE., desc.  
 57.20 Gully, 10 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course NE., asc.  
 61.40 Mining tunnel, 2.00 chs. S.  
 66.00 Top of spur, bears N., desc.  
 70.92 Intersect W. bdy. of the township 7.98 chs. N. 01° 21' W.  
 of the cor. of secs. 24 and 25.  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in  
 the ground for closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30, with  
 a brass cap, marked

 14.00 Foot of spur, gulch, 15 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, course W.  
 Asc. 150 ft.  
 15.50 Top of point of spur, bears W., desc.  
 Desc. 200 ft.  
 22.00 Foot of spur, gulch, 20 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, course  
 S 50° W.
