

Subdivision of T. 32 N., R. 37 E.

Chains August 15, 1913.
Beginning at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8, at 9h., 30 m., a. m., l. m. t., I set off $14^{\circ} 07'$ N. on the decl. arc, and $40^{\circ} 40'$ N. on the lat. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar:

Thence I run

West to a closing cor. bet. secs. 6 and 7.

Desc. along S. slope, over rough mountainous land.

11.50 Gully, 20 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course NW., asc.

16.00 Top of point of spur, bears N., desc.

27.50 Gully, 10 lks. wide, course N., asc.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with a brass cap, marked

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

43.00 Top of ridge, bears NW. and SE., desc.

64.00 Gully, 10 lks. wide, course NW., asc.

71.20 Intersect W. bdy. of township 5.60 chs. N. $1^{\circ} 02'$ W. of the cor. of secs. 1 and 12.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, with a brass cap, marked
