

Resurvey of the W. bdy. of T. 37 N., R. 38 E.

Chains

79.24 Intersect E. and W. line 35 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, which is a decayed willow stake, marks obliterated, set in a trace of an earth mound. Course of this mile is N. 0° 15' E.

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Beginning at the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, I retrace North on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 6.

40.00 Fail to find any trace of the old 1/4 sec. cor. Set temp. 1/4 sec. cor., and continue my line north.

81.60 Intersect E. and W. line 2.19 Chs. W. of the old cor. of Tps. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 37 and 38 E., which is a willow stake, 2 1/2 X 2 1/2 ins., 16 ins. above ground, marks illegible, set in a trace of an earth and stone mound. Course of this mile is N. 1° 32' E.

August 20, 1913.

At 9h., a. m., 1. m. t., at the cor. of Tps. 36 and 37 N., Rs. 37 and 38 E., I set off 12° 31' N. on the decl. arc and 41° 01' on the lat. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar;

Thence I run

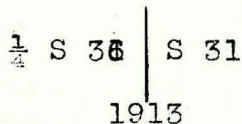
N. 0° 43' W. on a true line bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over rolling mountainous land covered with scattering sagebrush.

36.50 Dry wash, 20 lks. wide, 7 ft. deep, course NE.

40.00 Intersect the old 1/4 sec. cor.

I destroy all trace of the old cor. and at the same point Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for a new 1/4 sec. cor., with a brass cap, marked



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.
