

Chains.

- 12.00 Mountain spur, slopes N.W., descend steep N.W. slope of mountain.  
 40.00 On N.W. slope of mountain. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. with brass cap wk'd.

- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high W. of cor.  
 54.90 Dup ravine, course N.E., ascend steep S.E. slope  
 59.82 Intersect the 8th Standard Parallel North at  $S89^{\circ}E$ , 10.80 chs. from the Standard corner of secs. 34 and 35, re-established by me, Sept. 1, 1912.

Set a volcanic stone  $14 \times 9 \times 8$  ins., 10 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 2 and 3, marked CC on S. face, with 2 grooves on E. and 4 grooves on W. face, and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high S. of cor.  
 Land, high rocky, mountains. Soil, thin and rocky, wholly unfit for cultivation, 4th. rate. Good growth sagebrush, little grass, no timber.  
 Southwesterly and northwesterly slope.

On the N. ldy. of sec. 2, at a point midway between the closing corners of secs. 1 and 2, and secs. 2 and 3; Set a volcanic stone  $12 \times 8 \times 6$  ins., 8 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. N. of sec. 2, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the S. face, and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high S. of cor.
