N 0.2' W bet. secs. 3 and 4.

Ascending S. slope of mountains.

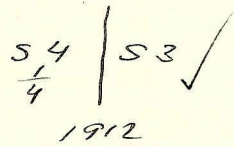
11.00 Mountain spur, slopes S.W.

21.00 Mountain spur, slopes W.

31.50 Ravine, course W.

32.65 Ravine, course S.W.

40.00 On S.W. slope of mountain side
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in diam.
24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
with brass cap mkd.

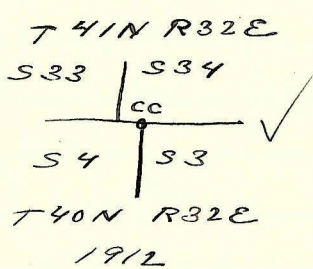


and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base
