

Chains.

- W. on a true line bet. sec. 30 and 31  
descending westerly slope.
- 20.80 Creek, 4 lks wide, flows S.W.
- 28.00 Ravine, course S.W.
- 33.20 Mountain spur, slopes S.
- 37.20 Ravine, course S.W.
- 40.00 In small ravine, course S.E.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam.  
2 1/4 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor.  
with brass cap mked.

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base  
1 1/2 ft. high N. of cor.

- 41.00 Mountain spur, slopes S.E.
- 49.10 Small ravine, course southerly.
- 60.45 Small ravine, course southerly.
- 71.00 On steep S. slope of mountain ridge.  
Intersect the W. ldy. of the tp. at N.  
30.40 chs. from the cor. of sec.  
25, 30, 31 and 36, which is an iron post  
firmly set in the ground, of the dimensions  
and marked and witnessed as described  
by the Surveyor General.  
Set a basalt stone, 17 x 9 x 7 ins., 12 ins.  
in the ground for closing corner of  
sec. 30 and 31, marked C C on E. face,  
with 5 grooves on N. and 1 groove on S. face  
and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base  
1 1/2 ft. high E. of cor.
- Land, rough volcanic mountains  
Soil, rocky, unfit for cultivation. 4th  
rate. Good growth sagebrush, little grass,  
quaking aspen and willows along the creek.  
Southerly slope.

On the W. ldy. of sec. 31, at a point midway  
between the closing corner of Tps. 39 and 40 N  
R 32 E, and the closing corner of sec. 30  
and 31, Set an iron post 3 ft. long
