Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 2 1/4 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.

Ascend over cliffs and rocks.

Intersect the 8th. Standard Parallel, North, at N 88° 20' E, 2.30 chs. from the standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, re-established by me Sept. 1, 1912.

Set a basalt stone 16 x 9 x 7 ins., 11 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 5 and 6, marked CC on S. face with 5 grooves on E. and 1 groove on W. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high S. of cor.

Land, rough volcanic mountains, huge rocks and cliffs.

Soil; rocky, practically non resistant. 4th. rate. Good growth sagebrush in places, little grass, no timber.

General S.E. slope.

On the N. bdy. of sec. 5 at a point N 88° 20' E, 40.02 1/2 chs. from the closing corner of secs. 5 and 6, set a basalt stone 16 x 9 x 7 ins., 11 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. N. of sec. 5, marked 1/4 on the S. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high S. of cor.
