

Chains.

On the N. bdy. of sec. 6, at a point S 88° 20' W, 40.00 chs. from the closing corner of secs. 5 and 6, Set a basalt stone, 17 x 11 x 6 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. N. of sec. 6 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the S. face, and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high S. of cor.

Since on the W. bdy. of T 40 N R 32 E I have set closing section corners, and $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cors., properly marked and witnessed for the W. tier of sections in T 40 N, R 32 E; the corners already set on this line, will now refer only to the E. tier of sections in T 40 N R 31 E, and I proceed to change the markings, and accessories, of these corners so that they now are as follows. Closing corner of T 40 N, Rs 31 and 32 E, I do not change as it is still the closing corner for T 40 N, Rs. 31 and 32 E.

$\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. east of sec. 1 is an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in diam, set 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. E. of sec. 1 with brass cap mkd.
