The falling of 1.17 chs. for the distance, now makes the course of this line N 0° 50' E.

I begin at the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36 and retrace

N 0° 50' E. bet. secs. 25 and 30

40.00 I search diligently but find no $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.20 I intersect the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30. It is a willow stake 2 ins. diam. by 16 ins. above ground, firmly set in the ground in a mound of earth, and marked with 4 notches on the N. and 2 notches on the S. side.

I retrace

N 0° 50' E bet. secs. 19 and 24, continuing my line.

40.00 I search diligently but find no $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 I search diligently but find no cor. for secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24.

I retrace, continuing my line.

N 0° 50' E bet. secs. 13 and 18

40.00 I search diligently but find no $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 I search diligently but find no cor. for secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18

I retrace, continuing my line.

N 0° 50' E bet. secs. 7 and 12

40.00 I search diligently but find no $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 I search diligently but find no cor. for secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12

I retrace, continuing my line

N 0° 50' E bet. secs. 1 and 6

40.00 I intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

It is a willow stake $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam. by 15 ins. above ground, firmly set in the ground in a mound of earth and marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face.
