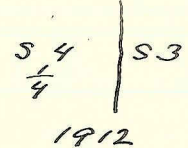


Subdivision of T44N, R38E

Chains
 56.25 Ravine, course N.W.
 78.00 Ridge, bears N.W. and S.E., divide between Skull creek and Flat creek.
 80.06 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10
 Land, rolling volcanic mountain. Soil, rocky. 4th. rate, unfit for cultivation
 Good growth sagebrush, little grass, willows along Flat creek, general N.W. slope.

N 0° 3' E. bet. secs. 3 and 4
 Over rolling mountains.
 2.50 Ridge, bears N.W. and S.E.
 17.80 Ravine, course N.E.
 20.10 Same ravine, course N.W.
 34.30 Road, bears N.W. and S.E.
 35.00 Leave rolling land, thence across level land.
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.



dig pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 3 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high W. of cor.
 43.50 Road, bears N.E. and S.W.

68.50 Rocky Gully, course N.W.
 77.23 Intersect the N. bdy. of the tp. at N 89° 40' E, 4.13 chs. from the cor. of secs. 33 and 34.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 3 and 4 with brass cap mkd.
