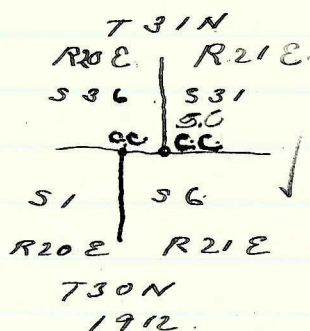


W. bdy. of T30N, R21E

Chains

104.03

3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth
3 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high W. of cor
Intersect the 6th. Standard Parallel
North at W. 28.40 ch. from the
standard corner of T31N, R20 and 21E.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 in.
diam. 24 ins. in the ground for
closing corner of T30N, R20 and 21E
with brass cap mkt.



dig pits 30x24x12 ins. crosswise on each
line, E. and W., 4 ft. and S. of post
8 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth
5 ft. base, 2 1/2 ft. high S. of cor.

Land; level, barren desert.

Soil; adobe, full of alkali and
other salts. 4th. rate, unfit for
cultivation.

No vegetation. Slight S.W. slope.

At the cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 N, R20 and 21E
established by me Dec. 12, 1912.

at 9 h. a.m. l.m.t. I set off
40.24' N on the lat. arc. 23° 09' S
on the decl. arc. and determine a
true meridian with the solar.

Thence I run

E, on the S. bdy. bet. sec. 6 and 31, on
the tangent

Over level, barren desert
