

Retracement of Subdivisions T. 32 N., R. 17 E., California. 21

Chains

13, which is a volcanic stone, 20x14x10 ins. set in a mound of stone, mkd. and witnessed as described by the surveyor general. As this cor. is not at the true intersection of the State Line, I move this cor. to its true position on the State Line, but preserve its location, by raising a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, at its original position; Thence S. 89° 21' W. on true line, 1.00 chs. dist. Intersect the New California-Nevada State Line at a point, 30.05 chs. S. 0° 37' E., of the 93 mile cor. At the point of intersection Set same volcanic stone, 20x14x10 ins., 15 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 12 and 13, mkd. CC on W; with 4 grooves on S. and 2 grooves on N. faces; and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor. The bearing of this line from the closing cor. to the old ¼ cor. bet. secs. 12 and 13 is therefore S. 89° 21' W. and the new length 12.32 chs.

Retracement of W. Bdy. T. 31 N., R. 18 E. Nevada.

From the old cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 17 and 18 E. Nevada, hereinafter described, I retrace South, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

40.02 Fall 61 lks. W. of the old ¼ cor. of secs. 1 and 6, hereinafter described. The bearing of this line is therefore N. 0° 52' W. and the length 40.02 chs.

From this ¼ sec. cor., I retrace South, Bet. secs. 1 and 6.

40.00 Found no trace of the old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12. Set temp. point.

From the temp. point for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, I retrace South, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

40.08 Fall 5 lks. E. of the old ¼ cor. of secs. 7 and 12, hereinafter described. The bearing of the line, from the old ¼ cor. of secs. 7 and 12 to the old ¼ cor. of secs. 1 and 6, is therefore N. 0° 02' E. and the length 80.08 chs.
