

## Retracement of the W. Bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 18 E. Nevada. 23.

Chains

- North, bet. secs. 19 and 24.
- 40.00 No trace of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of secs. 19 and 24, was found after a diligent search. Set temp. point.
- 80.16 Fall 67 lks. E. of the old cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, hereinafter described. The bearing of this line is therefore N.  $0^{\circ} 29'$  W., and the length 80.16 chs.
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- From the cor. of secs., 13, 18, 19 and 24, heretofore referred to, I retrace
- North, bet. secs., 13 and 18.
- 40.00 Fall 25 lks. E. of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of secs. 13 and 18, hereinafter described. The bearing of this  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile is therefore N.  $0^{\circ} 22'$  W., and the length 40.00 chs.
- From the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of secs. 13 and 18, I retrace
- North, bet., secs. 13 and 18.
- 39.91 Fall 17 lks. E. of the old cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, hereinafter described. The bearing of this  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile is therefore N.  $0^{\circ} 15'$  W. and the length 39.91 chs.

Resurvey of the W. Bdy. of T. 31 N., R. 18 E. Nevada.

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From the old cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 17 and 18 E. Nev., which is a lava stone, 20x16x4 ins., set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 6 grooves on N. S. and E faces. I rebuild this cor. and set same stone, 15 ins. in the ground, at its original position, mkd. with 6 grooves on each face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, S. of cor.

Thence

S.  $0^{\circ} 52'$  E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over rough rugged mountainous land, along broken E. slope, through, scattering undergrowth, and surface covered with loose rocks and numerous lava outcroppings, asc.

- 8.50 Point of low spur, 25 ft. above Tp. cor., projects S.  $60^{\circ}$  E.; desc.
