
Chains

From this point, a grove of Cottonwood and silver maple trees parallel both sides of road, passing through a narrow canyon to the E. of line and extending about 10 chs. dist. remains of an old stage station were observed at this grove of trees.

35.40 Top of ascent of ledges, about 70 ft. above creek, bears E. and W.; thence asc.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.


