

Retracement of the N. Bdy. of T. 31 N., R. 17 E. Nevada.

Chains

From the reestablished cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 17 and 18 E., Nev., previously described, I retrace West, on N. Bdy. of sec. 1.

24.95 Intersect the new California-Nevada State line, at a point, S. 1° 05' E., 25.34 chs. dist., from the 97 mile cor. previously described. Set temp. point.

40.00 Unable to find any trace of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

103.80 After a diligent search no trace of the old cor. of secs. 1 and 36 on the old original State Line, of California and Nevada was found.

Dependent

Resurvey of the N. Bdy. of T. 31 N., R. 17 E. Nevada.

From the reestablished cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 17 and 18 E. Nev., previously described. West, on a true line, on N. Bdy. of sec. 1.

Over rough rugged mountainous land, along E. slope, through scattering undergrowth, and over surface covered with loose lava rock; asc.

13.60 Top of rimrock of nearly level table land, 240 ft. above Tp. cor., bears NW. and SE.

24.95 Intersect the new California-Nevada State Line, at a point, S. 1° 05' E., 25.34 chs., from the 97 Mile cor., previously described. At the point of intersection,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock and 8 ins. in a mound of stone, for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 36, with brass cap mkd.
