WE, NEVADA AND CALIFORNIA LAND AND LIVE STOCK COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Nevada, being the owners of the following described lands:

$\frac{1}{2}$  of  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$  of  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$ , Lots 1, 8, and 9 of Section 13 in Township 31 North of Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. This land was granted by the United States of America to the State of Nevada and under date of June 3, 1872, the State of Nevada under a patent granted said lands to Harlan P. Cowles, which lands are described in said patent as  $\text{N}\frac{1}{2}$  of  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\text{N}\frac{1}{2}$  of  $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$ , Lot 1 of  $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\text{SE}\frac{1}{4}$  of  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 13, Township 31 North of Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

This land was granted by the United States of America to the State of Nevada and under date of June 3, 1872, the State of Nevada under a patent granted part of said lands to J. Humboldt Eaton, which lands are described in said patent as  $\text{SW}\frac{1}{4}$  or  $\text{SE}\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\text{SE}\frac{1}{4}$  or  $\text{SW}\frac{1}{4}$  or Section 13;  $\text{W}\frac{1}{2}$  of  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$  of  $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$  and  $\text{W}\frac{1}{2}$  of  $\text{SE}\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 24; and  $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$  or  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 25 of Township 32 North of Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. Under date of November 26, 1892, the State of Nevada granted under a patent to James G. Looper part of said lands, which lands are described in said patent as  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$  or  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$ , and  $\text{SE}\frac{1}{4}$  or  $\text{SE}\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 25; and  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$  or  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$  or Section 36 of Township 32 North of Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

hereby waive our rights to a metes and bounds survey of the above described land, and agree to adjust the boundaries thereof which extend into the State of California under the original Nevada Survey to the lines of the adjoining survey in California as follows:

$\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$  of  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 14;  $\text{N}\frac{1}{2}$  of  $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$ , and Lot 1 of Section 13 in Township 31 North of Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, California. The remaining original entry which is in Nevada is to conform to the Nevada Survey in Township 31 North of Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, Nevada.

Lot 1 of Section 25; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, and  $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$  of  $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 24;  $\text{SE}\frac{1}{4}$  of  $\text{SW}\frac{1}{4}$  and Lot 4 of Section 13 in Township 32 North of Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, California. The remaining original lands of these entries in Nevada is to conform to the Nevada Survey in Township 32 North of Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, Nevada.

Said waiver is made upon the condition and understanding that it will not cause the undersigned to lose any of the acreage of land in the above mentioned townships as given in the original patents covering any lands in the said townships which the undersigned now have title to or if it appears that such entries cannot be made to conform to the surveys as above mentioned without a loss of acreage to the undersigned that the United States of America will allow us to select lands adjacent to our lands in the above mentioned townships equal in acreage to that acreage lost and will give us patents covering the same.
