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General Description. The land in sections 6, 30 and 31, is very mountainous, broken rough and rocky. The spurs and ridges rise to an elevation of about 1000 ft. above the Truckee River . A small stream, named Dog creek, drains in a southerly direction through the W. half of sec. 6, While Truckee edt ai River, a clear water stream, about 2.50 chs. wide, and 180 831 from 3 to 5 ft. deep, flows through secs. 30 and 31 in a north easterly direction. The River flows through a narrow canyon therefore having no bottom land available for cultivation. The land is used for grazing purposes. · det A power plant, furnishing electricity for Virginia City is located near the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 29 and 30.
