and a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

I find no trace of the old sec. cor. at this point.

Course of this mile is S. 0° 17' E.

Beginning a new line at the cor. of secs. 25 and 36

Thence I run

South on a random line bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Intersect a point 19 lks. W. of the $\frac{1}{2}$ cor. of sec. 36, which is an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., set 12 ins. in the ground to bed rock, in a mound of stone, and marked

and a stone mound, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor. I find a lava rock, 12 X 14 X 18 ins., marked $\frac{1}{2}$, and also other evidence of the old cor. at this point, now rebuilt by Strover and Collins, as above described. Course of this half mile is S. 0° 17' E.

I begin a new line at this $\frac{1}{2}$ cor., and continuing same chaining, I run

South on a random line on the south half mile bet. secs. 31 and 36, and at

Intersect a point 10 lks. W. of the cor. of Tps. 40 and 41 N., R. 35 E., which is an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, and marked

and a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

I find the old stake and also other evidence of the old Twp. cor. at this point, now rebuilt by Strover and

Collins, as above described. Course of this half mile is S. 0° 8' E.
