Undergrowth scattering low sage-brush and grease-wood.
No drainage, flat.

West on a true line on the S. bdy. of sec. 32.

Over level land covered with scattering sage-brush and
grease-wood.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in
the ground for standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with a brass cap,

61.00 Dry wash, 6 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course N. 20° E.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 24 ins.
in the ground for standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32,
with a brass cap, marked
