Undergrowth scattering sage-brush and grease-wood, 2nd. rate.

No drainage, flat.

Over level land covered with sage-brush and grease-wood.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30, with a brass cap, marked
