

Resurvey West bdy. of T. 40 N., R. 38 E.

Chains June 16, 1914.

The west bdy. of the township was established in its original position by Strover and Collins, but as there are no subdivisions depending upon it, I destroy all trace of the reestablished cors., and survey N. from the cor. of Tps. 39 and 40 N., Rs. 37 and 38 E.

At 2h., p. m., l. m. t., I set off $23^{\circ} 21\frac{1}{2}'$ N. on the decl. arc, and $41^{\circ} 18'$ N., instrumental, on the lat. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar:--

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, with a brass cap, marked
