Chains North bet. secs. 1 and 6.
 Over level land sloping 3° to south.
 Asc. 280 ft. in the mile.
 10.00 Dry wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course SW.
 23.50 Dry wash, 6 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course SW.
 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins.

81.90 Intersect the 8th. standard Parallel North, 38 lks. W. of the cor. of T. 41 N., Rs. 37 and 38 E.
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of T. 40 N., Rs. 37 and 38 E., with a brass cap, marked

and dig pits, 30 X 24 X 12 ins. crosswise on the line, E. and W. 4 ft. dist., and S. 8 ft. and raise a mound of earth, 5 ft. base, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.
 The cor. of T. 41 N., Rs. 37 and 38 E. was marked last season for a cor. of four townships. I obliterate all marks on the S. half of the post leaving the marks for the N. tps. only. The mound which is of stone, I rebuild on the N. side of the post.

Land level, sloping 3° to S.
 Soil clay loam and clay sub-soil, 2nd. rate.
 Undergrowth dense sage-brush, 3 ft. high.
 Drains SW.
