

Subdivision of T. 40 N., R. 38 E.

Chains

June 22, 1914.

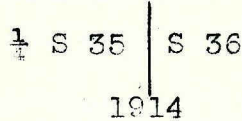
Beginning at the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of the township, at 8h., a. m., 1. m. t., I set off 23° 28' N. on the decl. arc, and 41° 18' N. on the lat. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar;

Thence I run

N. 0° 2' E. bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over level land covered with low sage-brush.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with a brass cap, marked



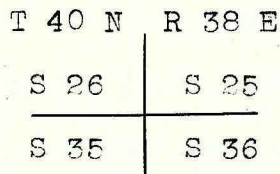
and dig pits, 18 X 18 X 12 ins. N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

44.50 Wagon road bet. Paradise Hill and Willow Pointley, bears NW. and SE.

47.70 Dry wash, 5 lks. wide, 12 ins. deep, course SE.

65.65 Wagon road bet. Paradise Hill and Paradise Valley, bears E. and W.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, with a brass cap, marked



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and dig pits, 18 X 18 X 12 ins. in each sec., 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. and raise a mound of earth, 3 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, dist., and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land level.

Soil clay loam and sandy, clay- sub-soil, 2nd. rate.

Undergrowth scattering low sage-brush.

Drains SE.
