80.03 Cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

Land rough mountainous.

Soil clay loam and stony, 3rd. rate.

Undergrowth scattering sage-brush.

Drains S. and SW.

Mountainous land 80.03 chs.

N. 0° 1' E. to a closing cor. bet. secs. 3 and 4.

Over rough mountainous land, asc. 362 ft.

15.50 Top of spur, bears S. 80° W., desc. 325 ft.

39.00 Canon 50 lks. wide with creek, 10 lks. wide, 4 ins deep, course SW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with a brass cap, marked



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

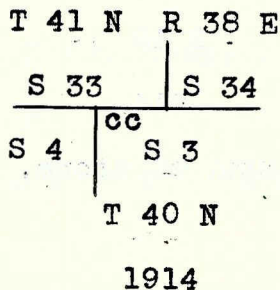
