

Subdivision of T. 40 N., R. 38 E.

Chains Drains SW.

N. 0° 1' W. to a closing cor. bet. secs. 5 and 6.
Over slightly rolling land, sloping S.

4.00 Dry wash, 14 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, course SW.

5.50 Dry wash, 12 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course SW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with a brass cap, marked



and dig pits, 18 X 18 X 12 ins. N. and S. of post, 3 Ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

49.20 Dry wash, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course SW.

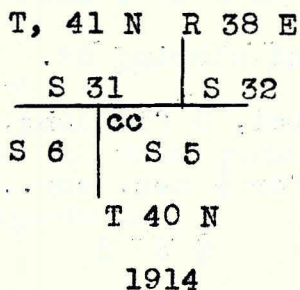
60.50 Dry wash, 7 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course SW.

67.90 Dry wash, 8 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course SW.

77.50 Old unused road, bears NW. and SE.

82.00 Intersect N. bdy. of the township 11.04 chs. N. 89° 54' W. of the Standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with a brass cap, marked



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land slightly rolling, sloping S.

Soil clay loam and sandy, 2nd. rate.

Undergrowth dense sage-brush, 2 ft. high.

Drains SW.
