

Retracement of S. Boundary of T. 32 N., R. 57 E.

Chs.

52.70 Top of sharp rugged spur, 100 ft. above canyon, projects S. 80° W.; desc.

80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., on a solid ledge and in a mound of stone for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, with brass cap mkd:

S25 | S30
S36 | S31

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor. This cor. is 660 ft. below spur.

Land, steep and rough mountainous of quartzite and granite formation.

No soil, but rock in the form of ledges, cliffs, boulders and slide rock.

No timber, undergrowth or grass.

N. 40.00 chs. drains NW.; S. 40.00 chs. drains W. Western exposure.

S. on a true line bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over steep and rough mountainous land; desc. abruptly over boulders and slide rock.

5.50 Bottom of canyon near head, 260 ft. below sec. cor., course W.; asc. over boulders and slide rock.

35.30 Top of rugged spur, 530 ft. above bottom of canyon, projects SW.; desc.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

S 36 | S 31

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor. This ¼ sec. cor. is 160 ft. below spur.

Owing to impassible cliffs on the S. 40.00 chs., I offset W. 6.19 chs. to a point 130 ft. above ¼ sec. cor., thence S; desc. abruptly over broken ledges.

62.30 Leave broken ledges, bears NW. and SE.

67.70 Enter heavy timber, bears E. and W.

80.00 Intersect the S. bdy. of the Tp., thence E. 6.19 chs. to the cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 57 and 58 E.

This cor. is 990 ft. below ¼ sec. cor.

Land, steep and rough mountainous of quartzite and granite formation.

Soil, shallow and mostly solid rock in the form of ledges, cliffs, boulders and slide rock N. 62.00 chs.; dark rocky loam about 1 ft. deep to solid rock S. 18.00 chs.

Timber, aspen and a few scattering spruce.

Undergrowth, dense young aspen, service berry and choke cherry bushes S. 40.00 chs. No undergrowth N. 40.00 chs.

Fair grazing S. 40.00 chs.

Drainage W.

N. 35.00 chs. exposed to the N; S. 45.00 chs. exposed to the S.

Retracement of S. Boundary of T. 32 N., R. 57 E.

From the old cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., which is an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, and marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General,

I retrace

W. on the S. bdy. bet. secs. 4 and 33.
