Fall 61 lks. W. of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. which is a badly decayed stake, hewn square and lying on top of ground; marks almost invisible. Reset cor. in ground.

From the temp. cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 56 and 57 E.,  
I retrace  
S. on the W. bdy. bet. sec. 5 and 6, is  
Fall 99 lks. E. of a badly decayed stake 2 ft. long, 3x3 ins. square and lying on top of ground; mark almost invisible. Reset the cor. in the ground.  
The course of the line bet. this cor. and the cor. of secs. 13 and 18 on the W. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 57 E. is N.  $0^{\circ}17'$  E. and the distance is 321.48 chs.; therefore, by proportion the true point for cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 56 and 57 E. is 79 lks. W. and 39 lks. N. of the temp. point. This gives the course of the line bet. the true point for cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 56 and 57 E. and the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of secs. 5 and 32 on the S. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 57 E. N.  $89^{\circ}49'$  W., and the distance is 120.79 chs.; therefore the true point for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 is 26 lks. W. and 13 lks. N. of the temp. point.

From the old cor. of Tps. 32 and 33 N., Rs. 57 and 58 E., heretofore described,  
I retrace  
W. on the N. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 57 E.  
After searching diligently at intervals of 40 and 80 chs., I am unable to find any evidence of cors., until at fall 15 lks. S. of the old cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34 which is a piece of a cedar stake 10 ins. long, 3 ins. square, loosely set in the ground, properly and plainly marked. Therefore the course of the line bet. this cor. and the old cor. of Tps. 32 and 33 N., Rs. 57 and 58 E. is N.  $89^{\circ}58'$  W. and the distance is 241.33 chs.; and by proportionate measurement the length of each half mile is 40.22 chs. ✓

Intersect the closing cor. of Tps. 32 N., Rs. 57 and 58 E., previously described.  
Wire fence on the W. side of alfalfa field, bears N. and S.  
Road from Holland's ranch to Lamoille, bears N.  $30^{\circ}$  E. and S.  $30^{\circ}$  W.  
Irrigation ditch, 2 lks. wide 6 ins. deep, course N.  
Irrigation ditch, 2 lks. wide 10 ins. deep, course N.
