- 29.68 Wire fence, bears NE. and SW.
- 30.80 Irrigation ditch, 2 lks. wide 8 ins. deep, course N.
- 38.56 Wire fence, bears N. and S.
- 40.22 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
