63.09	Creek of clear water, 8 lks. wide 1 ft. deep, in the bottom of hollow, 360 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 11, course N.; asc.
69.69	Creek of clear water, 5 lks. wide 6 ins. deep, course N.
80.48	The cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15, 90 ft. above hollow. Land, rolling mountainous with drainage and exposure to the NW. Soil, rocky dark loam about 2 ft. deep to rocky coarse brown clay subsoil. Timber, heavy aspen and willows along creeks. Undergrowth, dense sagebrush, rabbit brush, wild rose-bushes, service berry and choke cherry bushes. Good grazing.
5.30	From the cor. of secs. 11 and 12, N. on a true line bet. secs. 11 and 12. Over rolling mountainous land, through dense sagebrush and scattering rabbit brush; asc. Top of spur, 20 ft. above sec. cor., projects NW. 30.00 chs.; desc. abruptly.

77.91	The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, 60 ft. above draw. Land, rolling and rough mountainous of volcanic formation. Soil, rocky dark loam, 1 ft. to 2 ft. deep, to rocky coarse brown clay subsoil. Timber, heavy aspen and willows along creeks. Undergrowth, dense sagebrush, rabbit brush, wild rose-bushes, service berry and choke cherry bushes. Good grazing. Exposure and drainage NW.
40.00	From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, East on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 12.
76.27	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Intersect the E. bdy. of the Tp., 5.57 chs. S. of the cor. of secs. 6 and 7, heretofore described, and at the point of intersection set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12, with brass cap mkd:
