S.89°27'E. on a resurvey of S. Bdy. of sec. 36.  
Over mountainous land. No timber. Dense and abundant  
bunch grass.

- 15.75 Ridge, 400 ft. above section corner, bears NW. and SE.  
31.60 Ravine, with stream spring water, 1 lk. wide, 2 ins.  
deep, 210 ft. below ridge, course N.30°W.  
37.12 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia. 24 ins. in  
the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 1 only, with brass  
cap mkd:

An aspen 4 ins. in dia. bears S.38 $\frac{3}{4}$ °W. 82 lks. dist.,

in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 36 only, with  
brass cap mkd:

establish as follows:  
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins.

Undergrowth of sage, service brush, willows and laurel.

Abundant growth of grass.

RETRACEMENT OF E. BDY. of T. 42 N., R.61 E.

Oct. 23, 1914: At 2 h 0 m P.M., l.m.t., I set off 41°  
29'N. on the lat. arc; 11°19'S. on the decl. arc; and  
determine a meridian at the cor. of T. 42 N., Rs. 61 and  
62 E.

Thence I run

North on a retracement between secs. 31 and 36.
