

- 42.20 Spur of ridge, 100 ft. above creek, bears S.60°E.;
descend.
- 44.20 Bottom of draw, 30 ft. below top of spur, course SE.;
ascend.
- 53.40 Spur of ridge, 210 ft. above draw, bears S.60°E.; desc.
- 59.40 North branch of Garrant creek, running water, 3 lks.
wide, 2 ins. deep, 135 ft. below top of spur, course
S.60°E.; ascend 350 ft. to the closing corner.
- 70.77 Intersect the North Bdy. of the township, 4.79 chs.
S.89°44'E. of the cor. of secs. 32 and 33. At the
point of intersection I build a closing corner as
follows:
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins.

Soil, coarse gravelly and rocky clay loam, outcrops of
quartzite rock in many places.

Undergrowth, sage and service brush, good growth of
bunchgrass, willows along the creeks.

Timber, quaking aspen in ravines and creeks.

Land, suitable for grazing only.

Nov. 20, 1914: At 7 h 55 m A.M., l.m.t., I set off
41°30'S. on the lat. arc; 19°31'S. on the decl. arc, and
determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs.
28, 29, 32 and 33.

Thence I run

West on a Sectional Correction Line between secs. 29
and 32.

Over mountainous land, ascend through dense mahogany
timber.

- 24.00 Spur of high rocky mountain, 345 ft. above section
corner, bears SE.; descend.
- 38.10 Bottom of draw, 100 ft. below top of spur, course
S.30°E.; ascend.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins.
in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
S 29
 $\frac{1}{4}$
S 32
1914
- from which:
A mahogany 7 ins. in dia. bears S.29°E., 28 lks.
dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S32BT.
A mountain mahogany 11 ins. in dia. bears N.21°15'E.,
17 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S29BT.
- 47.30 Spur of mountain, 210 ft. above draw, bears S.20°E.;
descend.
- 63.40 Bottom of draw, 160 ft. below spur, course S.20°E.; asc.
- 72.20 Rocky spur, of mountain, 400 ft. above draw, bears S.20°W.,
descend 265 ft. to the section corner.
- 80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins.
in the ground for the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32,
