


West on a true line between secs. 6 and 7.
Over mountainous land, ascend.

- 11.50 Head of draw, course SE.; asc.
- 15.30 Top of ridge, 200 ft. above section corner, bears N.20°W. and S.20°E.; descend.
- 34.70 Bottom of draw, 100 ft. below top of ridge, course S.; ascend.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 8 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

- 41.70 Top of rocky ridge, 120 ft. above bottom of draw, bears S.30°W. and N.30°E.; descend.
- 68.30 Bottom of draw, 210 ft. below top of ridge, course S.; spring of water 5 chs. S. of line in draw; ascend.
- 74.60 Top of ridge, 70 ft. above bottom of draw, bears S.30°W. and N.30°E.; descend 130 ft. to the closing corner.
- 86.07 Intersect the W. Bdy. of the township 7.37 chs. N.0°38'E. of the cor. of secs. 1 and 12 of T. 42 N., R. 60 E. At the point of intersection I build a corner as follows:
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the C.C. of secs. 6 and 7, with brass cap mkd:





Soil, rocky dark clay loam, outcropping ledges of quartzite.
Undergrowth, sagebrush, serviceberry and buckbrush, good growth of bunchgrass; willows along creek.
No timber. Nov.25,1914.

Knowing that the line between secs. 5 and 6 will not close within limits, I run N.0°03'W. on a true line between secs. 5 and 6.
Over mountainous land, desc.

- 6.00 Creek, water 1 lk. wide, 70 ft. below sec. cor., course S.35°E., asc.
- 34.00 Spur of mountain, 480 ft. above creek, bears SW., desc.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

- 45.00 Bottom of draw, 100 ft. below top of spur, course S.30°W.; ascend 480 ft. to the closing corner.
- 71.17 Intersect the N. Bdy. of the Tp. 4.71 chs. S.89°01'E. of the cor. of secs. 31 and 32 of T. 43 N., R. 61 E., heretofore described. At the point of intersection I build a corner as follows:
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the C.C. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd:
