

Retracement of the Nevada-Utah State Line,
along the E. boundary of T. 21N., R. 70E.

Chains.

N. on retracement of 112th. mile.

Ascending over rough mountainous land, through dense timber.

19.00 Top of spur, slopes S. 10° W.

39.00 Dry wash, 4 lks. wide, course S. 30° W.

63.00 After diligent search, I fail to find any evidence of old post.

73.00 Top of spur, bears S. 45° W. and N. 45° E.

80.00 Set a temp. point.

Land, rough mountainous.

Soil, very rocky; 4th. rate; quartzite.

Timber, juniper and pinion pine.

Undergrowth, desert brush.

Mountainous land, 80 cha.

Dense timber, 80 cha.

Continue N. on retracement of 111th. mile.

Over rough, mountainous land, through dense timber.

42.50 Bottom of ravine, with dry wash 4 lks. wide, course S. 70° W.

73.50 Bottom of ravine, with dry wash, 2 lks. wide, course S. 50° W.

76.88 110th. mile post, bears W., 14 8 lks. dist.

A mahogany post, 4 ins. x 4 ins. x 5 ft., set in a mound of stone, marked Nevada on W., Utah on E., and 110 M on S. face.

Bearing tree, as described in old notes.

The course of a direct line from the 112th. to the 110th. mile post, is N. $0^{\circ} 32'$ W.; and the distance is 156.88 cha.

Land, rough mountainous.

Soil, very rocky, 4th. rate.

Timber, juniper, pinion pine and mountain mahogany.

Undergrowth, desert brush.

Dense timber and mountainous land, 76.88 cha.
