July. 17, 1913: From the cor. of Tps. 13 and 14 N. R. 26 and 27 E. I retrace

W. bet. secs. 1 and 36

39.90 The old $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 1 and 36, which is a granite stone $4 \times 8 \times 14$ ins. above ground, firmly set, in a mound of stone, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General bears E. 8 lbs. dist.,

The course of this $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is therefore $S 89^{\circ} 53' W$.

I continue my retracement along same line

79.53 Intersect N. and S. line 16 lbs. N. of cor. secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 which is a granite stone $8 \times 6 \times 14$ ins. above ground, firmly set in a mound of stone, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

The course of last $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is therefore $S 89^{\circ} 53' W$.
