

Resurvey of E. bdy. T. 14 N., R. 26 E.

Chains

July 19, 1913:

From the cor. of Tps. 13 and 14 N. Rs. 26 and 27 E. I run East and at 1.85 Chs., which by previous retracement is a point 242.02 Chs. south of the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, T. 14, N., R. 26 E., establish a cor. of 2 Tps. as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of Tps. 14 N. Rs. 26 and 27 E. with brass cap mkt.;

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and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

I obliterate the markings on the N. edge of the old cor. of Tps. 13 and 14 N. Rs. 26 and 27 E. and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor. thus making it a cor. of Tps. 13 N., Rs. 26 and 27 E. Thenceafter.

At 8⁴⁵ 30^m a.m., l.m.t. I set off 39' 1' N. on the lat. arc; 20' 54' N. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the established cor. of Tps. 14 N. Rs. 26 and 27 E.

Thence I run North on true line bet. secs. 31 and 36 low broken and rolling land descend W. slope
