dig pits, 18x18 x 12 ins., in each sec. 5 1/2 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, w. of cor.

From the old 1/4 cor. of secs. 7 and 12 I retrace north bet. secs. 7 and 12 intersect E. and W. line 50 lbs. W. of the old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12 which is a trap stone 5x8x8 ins. above ground firmly set in a mound of stone, marked with 5 notches on the S. edge and 1 notch on the north.

The course of this last 1/2 mile is therefore N 0° 43' E.

From the old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12 I retrace north bet. secs. 1 and 6. The old 1/4 cor. of secs. 1 and 6, which is a basalt stone 8x10x14 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, marked with 4 on the west, witnessed by mound of stone on the west. bears E. 29 lbs. dist.

The course of this 1/2 mile is N 0° 25' E

I continue my retracement along same line.
