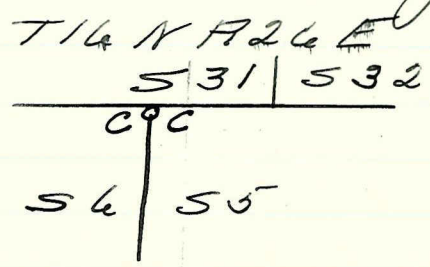


Subdivision of T. 15 N., R. 24 E.

Chains and raise a mound of stone,
2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
45.00 Base of descent. gradually
ascend over land draining E.
57.70 Wash, 10 lbs. wide, course SE.
69.53 Intersect 3^d Standard Parallel
North, 28.46 Chs. west of the
standard cor. of secs. 31 and
32, T. 14 N. R. 24 E. previously
described. At the point of
intersection I build a cor.
as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long,
2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground for closing cor. of secs.
5 and 6, with base cap mkd.:



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and raise a mound of stone,
2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Undergrowth, sage and desert
