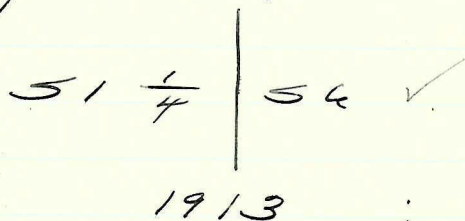


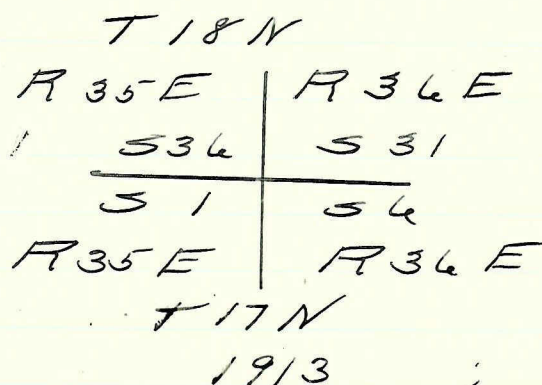

40.00 North bit. secs. 1 and 6
low valley land, gradually ascend
Set an iron post 3 ft. long,
1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground for $\frac{7}{4}$ sec. cov. with
brass cap mtd.;



80.00 and raise a mound of stone,
2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cov.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long,
3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground for cov. of Tps. 17 and
18 N., Rs. 35 and 36 E. with
brass cap mtd.;



and raise a mound of stone,
2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cov.

Land, gently rolling valley

Undergrowth, sage and desert brush
